***2 yard 5 m/m (air weight) silks 90,000 won (\$84.00 if paid online) \_\_\_\_\_***

***\*It includes all materials needed to make a 2 yard (1.8 meter) silk.***

***Add additional silks per person and save!***

***3 yards silk - 105,000 Won (\$98.00 if paid online) \_\_\_\_\_***

***4 yards silk - 120,000 Won (\$112.00 if paid online) \_\_\_\_\_***

***\$14.00/yard (15,000 won)extra for each additional yard of silk or 8 m/m (water weight)***

***\*Students can choose 5 m/m (air weight) or 8 m/m (water weight) silks again,***

***\*Fees include all materials needed to make a 2 yard x 44" silk.***

***Fees cover cost of Instructor, professional dyes, urea, soda ash soak, silk (5m/m - air weight), gloves and other miscellaneous materials needed as well as Instructions.***

***\*\*\* if there is interest some specialty silks can be made available  
(pre-hemmed in various patterns/textures) for 40,000 won each***

***\*\*All silk can be cut into smaller pieces to make multiple smaller works in the class (for example you can get one 45x36" and two 22x70" scarves from a 3 yard silk or two 22x72" scarves from a 2 yard silk)***

***\*Students may want to bring a package of clothing clips, 1 pkg small clips and 1 pkg of larger ones to try certain designs***

***\*\*\* Available at DAISO for 1000 won a pkg***

**\*\*\*Note: Silk dying classes are one where you have a 99% chance of getting dye on your clothes, so please dress accordingly. Plan to get messy!**

**\*\*\* (cheap clothes that you don't mind the colours changing and some cheap sandals or flip-flops so your feet don't end up pretty colours too!)**

- **Minimum age is 10 years (12 in Korean age). All minors must be accompanied by their parent.**
  - \* **3 yard silk registration required: 3 yard silks - 105,000 Won (\$98.00 if paid online)**
- **A minimum number of students required. Must have 9 registrants per Workshop by January 25th**
  - **Instruction is mainly in English (limited Korean and German translation available)**
  - **Students will be provided with all basic materials and an instruction booklet (in English). All materials are provided for in the workshop fee.**
  - **The workshops will be limited to 12 students, so RSVP as soon as possible**
  - **The balance of fees will be collected at the beginning of the class or can be paid online.**

**\*\*\*This workshop uses professional Fiber Reactive Procion Dyes. Not the ones you can buy on the cheap at the supermarket. All colors are brilliant, mouth-watering, and permanent. They don't fade, even after repeated washings. They are safe and easy to use. Superior to supermarket dyes in every way!**

**USED FOR: Tie-Dye, Tub Dyeing, Low Immersion Dyeing, Batik, Dye Painting, Silk Painting, Screen & Block Printing or Stenciling, even Tie-dyeing Silk in a Microwave**

**USED ON: All natural Fibers (Cotton, Rayon, Hemp, Silk, etc.), Wood, Cane, and Rattan**

**You may have seen other silk dying workshops for less that took less time, but please remember, in most of these, participants dyed small scarf-sized pieces with an additional emphasis of using them in our homes as small table cloths or wrapped around pillow forms. Not long lengths of heavier silk that uses much more time, material, dye and fixative.**
